These are analysed from a world-historical and, to some extent, a political economy perspective. The overall conclusion that emerges from this volume is that in order to formulate an adequate political philosophy for the modern age, both the western and Indian traditions have to be taken into account. In this context, some of the essays highlight the contemporary global relevance of Gandhi's socio-political ideas. This book is a major contribution to modern political philosophy.
