else possessing only the text of the *Geography* could reproduce Ptolemy's map at any time, in whole or in part, at any scale. Here Berggren and Jones render an exemplary translation of the *Geography* and provide a thorough introduction, which treats the historical and technical background of Ptolemy's work, the contents of the *Geography*, and the later history of the work.
