difficult to take in at once, so this book overcomes this difficulty by implementing a simple idea. First, systems will be described as Windows-based. We are very familiar with Windows, so it is very easy to understand a description based on Windows. For hacking, it is necessary to connect at least three or more computers on a network.
